Goh Pei Sheng is presently the Vice President (Digital Industry Singapore) in EDB, and oversees the promotion and development of digital technology sector in Singapore, specifically fast growth Digital companies from China, India, and Southeast Asia. From 2013 to 2014, he was also attracting investments from Taiwanese companies. Pei Sheng is also familiar with the private sector and was an applications engineer with an American MNC, supporting the start-up of then Chartered Semiconductor Fab 7.
